

ORDINANCE 03-12

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND CLARIFYING THE MOST CURRENT LEGISLATION ON SUBJECTS WITH DUPLICATED OR PRIOR LEGISLATION, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee of the Council of the Village of Rockford, Ohio has been diligently reviewing all legislation passed by the Village in an attempt to better organize and readily access legislation.

WHEREAS, Council desires to establish and clarify the most current legislation on a particular subject if there is prior legislation on the same subject in order to avoid duplication and confusion.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCKFORD, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. In the event that there are multiple pieces of legislation on the same or similar subject, the most recent legislation shall be controlling. In that event, the newest legislation shall supersede the prior legislation, unless the newest legislation specially provides otherwise.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall apply to all legislation passed on or prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
